



EXPERIENCE THEATRE!

Course Synopsis:

“Experience Theatre!” is a two hour, hands on programme tailored specifically to engage participants in the theatre experience.

By going through activities like theatre games, participants will feel comfortable with themselves as performers, and will find a new sense of freedom in expression.

Accompanied by stage basics, they will then have an idea about the stage area, where to enter and exit and what some of the theatre lingo is.

The course will incorporate a short 5 – 10 minute skit that will allow the participants to use their newfound skills and confidence in a no-pressure setting.

Course Objectives:

The objectives of “Experience Theatre!” are:

1. Promote theatre as a form of art and expression
2. Develop the participants’ sense of confidence and expression
3. Provide them with a new avenue for expression and possible development.

Course Trainer:

Alex is the writer, composer and librettist of “I Want To Be A Star!”. His debut musical, “Believe” met with critical approval, coming in second in the Singapore Arts Festival Selection Event in 2007. It subsequently ran six sell out shows at the Esplanade Recital Studio.

He directed and vocal-coached “I Want To Be A Star!” with Holy Innocents’ High School, with a total cast size of over 200 students, in celebration of their 50th anniversary, as well as Stella Kon’s “Blue Willow House” which uses state-of-the-art 3D back projection as part of the set.

A singer/ songwriter of fifteen years, Alex has released two English albums “Someday” (2003) and “Veritas” (2005). He is also the top 10 winner of the 2005 National Day Song-writing Competition (for “Wings”)

An experienced teacher, Alex uses humour and stories to bring across life messages to his students, making his time with them both educational and fun.
